



**\*\*\*MORGAN CENTRE & PARISH HALL - FORCED CLOSURES  
&  
SUSPENSION OF MEETINGS & SURGERIES\*\*\***

The Parish Council has been forced to close its halls (Morgan Centre & Parish Hall) with immediate effect as they are both leisure buildings which the government has announced must shut to combat the spread of Coronavirus.

The Parish Council is so sorry that this measure is necessary as we know how many of the community take part in groups & activities in our halls.

Our buildings will reopen as soon as permitted by central government.

Our play areas and the Morgan Recreation Ground remain open, but we would remind everyone of the need to observe the 2 metre social distancing protocol with any one outside of their normal family/household. If central government directs that play areas and parks must close, then these facilities will also have to close as soon as reasonably practicable after such an announcement.

Our staff are continuing to work on Council matters via remote services at home. Like all organisations, we are short staffed with one third of our staff on medically imposed self isolation despite not showing symptoms of Coronavirus. It may therefore take us longer than anticipated to get back to you.
