

# NOTICE OF ELECTION

## Election of a Parish Councillor for the CROWTHORNE ward of Crowthorne Parish Council

1. An Election is to be held of one Parish Councillor for the Crowthorne ward of Crowthorne Parish Council.
2. Forms of nomination may be obtained from Electoral Services, Easthampstead House, Town Square, Bracknell, RG12 1AQ from the Returning Officer who will, upon request prepare a nomination paper for signature.
3. Nomination papers must be delivered to the Returning Officer, Easthampstead House, Town Square, Bracknell, RG12 1AQ on any day after the date of this notice but no later than 4 pm on Friday, 27 October 2017.
4. If an election is contested the poll will take place on **Thursday, 23<sup>rd</sup> November 2017**.
5. Any person wishing to be registered as a voter eligible to vote on 23 November 2017 must apply to be registered by no later than midnight on Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> November 2017. The quickest way to apply is by entering the requisite details on the national registration website [www.gov.uk/register tov ote](http://www.gov.uk/register tov ote)
6. Electors and their proxies should take notice that new applications to vote by post or amendments to or cancellations of existing postal and proxy records must reach the Electoral Services Office at the above address by 5 pm on Wednesday, 8<sup>th</sup> November 2017.
7. New applications to vote by proxy at these elections must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the above address by 5 pm on Wednesday, 15<sup>th</sup> November 2017.
8. An elector can apply to appoint an emergency proxy up to 5pm on polling day if they
  - have had a medical emergency\* after 5pm on Wednesday, 15th November 2017.  
\*The form must be supported by a registered medical practitioner or a registered nurse. If the elector lives at a residential home or in sheltered housing, the matron, home care director or warden may support the applicationOr;
  - cannot go to the polling station due to their occupation, service or employment which they only became aware of after 5pm on Wednesday, 15th November 2017.
9. For an application due to occupation, service or employment, the attestation must be made by the employer (or delegate) or for self employed people, by an adult who knows them but is not related to the elector.
