

CROWTHORNE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

HAVE YOUR SAY



Following the work of the Neighbourhood Planning Group, including representatives from both Crowthorne Village Action Group, Crowthorne Traders and volunteers from within the community, Crowthorne Parish Council has now prepared its Pre-Submission Plan for your area including:

- Design guidelines for each neighbourhood character area
- Enhancing the street scene and retail offer in the village
 - Safeguarding employment in Crowthorne
 - Green infrastructure – e.g. cycle/footpaths
- Biodiversity policy – ensuring that development proposals must result in a biodiversity gain for the Parish
- Recognition of the areas within the Council's boundaries that are protected from development by legislation due to SSSI status and the Thames Basin Heaths Special Protection Area

The proposed Plan takes into account that there are no large areas within the Parish Council boundaries that are available for development that have not already been included in the Bracknell Forest Borough Council's Site Allocations.
